As you all know we are a Nut Free School. Due to the number and severity of nut allergies, it is important to keep all of our students safe. When bringing in snacks for your student to share with their classmates during a special event such as a birthday celebration or international week, **please read all food labels to make sure that the food was not produced in a factory where peanuts/nuts are processed.** Please also be mindful when packing your child's lunch that you do not send peanut butter or nuts.

Our school policy requires that you let the teacher know at least two days in advance before bringing in any food that will be shared with the class, as we do have milk and egg allergies as well. If we all take care to be aware of the ingredients used in the food we send with our students to school, I am positive we will be able to keep all of our students safe.
