### 2<sup>nd</sup> Child Discount

We offer a discount for families that have two or more children attending camp. The discount does not apply to specialty camps or supply fees. Discount is applied to the second child's camp fees.

## Specialty Camps and Add on Registration Process

We are excited to offer specialty camps that can be added on to your weekly activities or as a separate camp all together. Specialty camps require the same forms as well as the \$50.00 registration fee. Add on camps do not require additional registration fees or additional paper work. The same cancellation and payment policies apply. **Children who attend specialty camps may not be able to go to the pool Tuesday's and Thursday's depending on timing.**

### Payment Options:

We accept checks written to St. Philip School or cash. **Full payment for the week is required to be made by the Thursday 5 pm before your child attends camp for that week.**

### Cancellation Policy:

We understand that changes to your schedule can occur. You may change your week of enrollment without a fee, as long as we receive notice one week before the change is to occur. Otherwise the full tuition is owed.

### Late Payment Policy:

**All accounts will be reconciled Thursday at the end of the work day (5 pm). Late fees will be added at 5:01 pm Thursday. Full payment for the week is required to be made by the Thursday before your child attends camp for that week. If your payment is late, there will be an additional late fee of \$50.00.**

Policies and Procedures:

- I understand if I need to make changes to the weeks I have registered, I should contact Mrs. Shari Jeshow, [sjeshow@stphilipecc.org](mailto:sjeshow@stphilipecc.org) immediately with at least one week's notice. If I do not give one week's notice, I am aware I will be charged for a full week of camp tuition.
- I understand that if I must withdraw my child, I am required to provide one week's notice in writing to Mrs. Shari Jeshow, [sjeshow@stphilipecc.org](mailto:sjeshow@stphilipecc.org)
- I understand my child will not be released to anyone that is not on my authorized pickup list and that my child must be picked up by 1 pm if half day or 6 pm if p.m. half day or full day, each and every day. If I am late, I will be charged a \$1.00 per minute fee until I arrive.
- I understand my child needs to be signed in and out each day by a parent, legal guardian or authorized person.
- If my child is experiencing problems in the program, a conference will be arranged between parent, camp teachers and Program Director, Mrs. Stich. I understand Camp Corpus Christi / St. Philip will communicate with parents, guardians, authorized drop off and pick up persons regularly to ensure successful programs.
- I understand if any of the contact information of the parents, guardians, or emergency contact changes, it is the responsibility of the parent to inform Mrs. Shari Jeshow, [sjeshow@stphilipecc.org](mailto:sjeshow@stphilipecc.org).

Illness Policy

- I will pick up my child within 1 hour of being notified.
- If my child becomes ill (vomits, has diarrhea, or a fever over 100 degrees), I will be contacted. I understand my child must be fever free and symptom free **without any medication** for 24 hours before returning to camp.
- I understand if my child is vomiting or has diarrhea before coming to camp, I will keep my child home.

## Swimming at Woodley Pool

Corpus Christi /St. Philip Camp includes swimming at Woodley Pool two days per week (Tues. & Thurs.) from 10:30 AM – 12:15 PM. Children need to come dressed in their bathing suits, accompanied by a **small** swimming towel labeled with their name and a coat of sunscreen prior to arriving at camp. You may also send sunscreen; their names must be labeled clearly on the bottle as well as the medication authorization form attached. We are lucky that the pool is within walking distance.

Each child will receive a wrist band each day designating their swimming level, which they wear in the pool each day. Please mark which color is best for your child.

This will consist of swimming a length of the pool and treading water for a minute. This test will be given by a certified lifeguard.)
